**Daily Price - \$25.00/per child**

**½ Day (8:30-11:30) - \$15.00/per child**

**3 Days - \$70.00 per week /per child**

**5 Days - \$100.00 per week/per child**

- A completed Kamp Registration Form is required for attendance.
- A copy of updated immunizations is required for attendance.
- Children will need to bring a lunch. (Lunchables are available for \$3.00.)
- Pizza Day will be on Tuesday each week. Parents may purchase pizza for \$1.25 a slice and \$.25 per breadstick. Please pay your child's teacher for pizza orders by Monday.
- Scheduled field trips will be on Wednesdays at an additional charge.

**Time** - 8:30AM - 3:00PM (Children may be dropped off any time after 8:15AM and picked up by 3:15PM at no additional charge.)

**Extended childcare** is available for an additional \$3.00/hr from 6:30 AM-8:30AM and 3:00 PM - 6:00 PM.
